CENTENNIAL, Colo., September 2, 2010 – John Zayac, pilot of the McDonald Racer #37, will be competing in the T-6 Gold Class, 47th Annual National Championships Air Races, also known as the *Reno Air Races*. The races will take place September 15th – September 19th, 2010 at the Reno Stead Airport in Nevada.

As an experienced pilot, licensed for over 20 years, he has competed in the annual air races for the past 10 years as one of the top T-6 race pilots in the world. After winning first place in the T-6 Bronze Class in 2003, he's advanced through the T-6 Silver Class and currently races in the highly competitive T-6 Gold Class.

Regarding the team's 2010 air race goals, Zayac states, "Our three major goals for 2010 Reno Air Races are to promote children interested in aviation, break and maintain the T-6 air racing speed record of 244.523 mph, and to win first place in the T-6 Gold..." -John Zayac
