Regarding the team's 2010 air race goals, Zayac said, "Our three major goals for 2010 Reno Air Races are to promote children interested in aviation, break and maintain the T-6 air racing speed record of 244.523 mph, and to win first place in the T-6 Gold." The McDonald Racer Crew is a unique team comprised of expert mechanics, skilled pilots, race strategy engineers, photographers, business profes-
